

Wichard Lifeline system

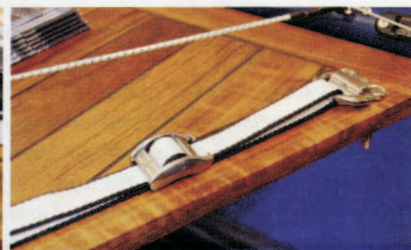


French hardware specialist Wichard's new Lifeline consists of a substantial forged buckle, buckle cover, pad-eyes and webbing straps. It is a one-size product supplied with various different lengths of webbing from 6m-15m (20ft-49ft).

The polypropylene buckle cover is luminous so will also glow in the dark, and includes a

rubber underside that serves to protect decks and superstructures from damage by the buckle. The webbing also incorporates reflective strips.

Bioinox's Polaris passarelle
